PORTEL

The county of Portel is located in the south of the District of Évora, almost equal distance between the cities of Évora and Beja (at 40 and 35 kms respectively) to which it is linked by the main road IP2. In administrative terms, the county is divided into eight parishes: Alqueva, Amieira, Monte do Trigo, Oriola, Portel, Santana, S. Bartolomeu do Outeiro and Vera Cruz.

Situated at the border between the Alto and Baixo (North and south) Alentejo, the county gains most of its physical characteristics from the Portel mountains, a geological feature shaped like an elongated horseshoe with its tips pointing westward. Between the two lines of mountains there is a zone of lowlands irrigated by numerous waterways.

As regards woodland, the county is characterized by a predominance of oak groves (both cork oaks and holm oaks). The mountainsides are covered with Mediterranean-style vegetation (the species found there are largely responsible for the particular quality of the local honey) and there are also large stretches of olive groves, the basis of one of the county's most significant sources of wealth, namely its high quality olive oil.

The mark of man can be seen in two important reservoirs, Alvito and Alqueva, which mark the western and easternmost limits of the county respectively.

Historically, the county of Portel dates from the middle of the 13th century, when in 1257, D. João Peres de Aboim, later known as D. João de Portel, came into possession of an extensive area, detached from the county of Évora. This became the county of Portel when the town was granted its charter in 1262. Considerably later, in the middle of the 19th century, its boundaries were extended to include a new area from the former county of Oriola.

The town of Portel practically came into existence with D. João de Portel, and developed in the shade of the castle, founded or remodeled by him. It was taken over by the Crown in 1301 during the reign of Dinis, but later, in 1385, fell into the possession of D. Nuno Álvares Pereira, who in turn passed it on, in 1422, to his grandson D. Fernando. From that moment, Portel belonged to the House of Bragança.

Built on a high hill, the fortifications contain two rows of walls. An outer wall made of loam, surrounds the Old Town and the castle, which was transformed in the 16th century into a fortified palace.

With time, however, the Old Town within the walls was gradually abandoned. A new settlement developed, first just outside the outer walls on the slopes of the hill and then spreading downwards in a northeasterly direction, because of the highways leading to Évora. Later, in the modern age, a new urban area developed to the south of the historical centre, regular in shape.

The most significant monument in Portel town is certainly the fortifications on the hill, dominated by its eight-sided castle and the impressive keep, supposedly erected during the reign of D. Dinis. As for the great loam wall surrounding the hill, this is believed by some to be Arab in origin, while others argue that it was built by D. João de Portel.



As for Portel's religious buildings, the most significant are: the Church of the Misericordia (17th century); the Chapel of Santo António (16th – 17th centuries), whose interior is decorated with 17th century tiles; the Church of the Espirito Santo (16th century), the Mother Church (18th century) and the convent/ church of Nossa Senhora do Socorro (beginning of 17th century), amongst others. Other important buildings include several houses dating back to the 16th and 17th centuries and, especially, stately homes from the 18th and 19th centuries.

Throughout the county, there are many places in the Portel mountains (such as the Hermitage of São Pedro or the heights of São Bartolomeu do Outeiro) which offer magnificent views of the surrounding areas, and there are also a number of isolated chapels. Of the village churches, some (such as the parish churches of Amieira, Oriola, Santana and São Bartolomeu do Outeiro) date back to medieval times but were restored in the Manueline era.

However, the most significant church in the whole county, in historical, architectural and religious terms, is certainly the church of Vera Cruz, which began as a Visigoth temple in the 6th-7th centuries. The monastery of Vera Cruz de Marmelar was one of the most important medieval sanctuaries in the country, famous because of its relic of the Santo Lenho (Holy Cross), which it still holds today.

Finally, on a different level, we should not overlook the importance for the county, both economically and as a tourist attraction, of the reservoir of Alqueva.

There are viewing points in the hills throughout the county of Portel where the visitor can enjoy magnificent views across much of the region. These are places with hermitages, or villages that are authentic belvederes, places where you can appreciate the great diversity of landscape. Some of these viewing spots are situated in the mountains, with their wealth of different plant species; some in the yards of the modest hermitages perched on the hills (São Pedro, São Lourenço), and there is one on top of the keep of Portel's castle. There are views that stretch over the crests of the mountains, across the lowlands and gentle slopes framed by the sheets of water of the reservoirs of Alvito (São Bartolomeu do Outeiro) and Alqueva (Santo António de Alqueva and Mira Lagos), and across the town of Portel itself (Santa Catarina).

The county of Portel has the infrastructures to offer excellent conditions for sports and leisure activities. Fishing in the reservoirs and hunting in the game reserves are also alternatives for those who appreciate such sports.

Visitors may also appreciate the traditional food of the region, prepared in the various restaurants in the county. If you are staying overnight, there are many hotels that will put you up in comfort.

TRADITIONAL FESTIVALS

When the summer comes, the county is flooded with people from outside, such as the many local people that have immigrated, but return each year for the traditional festivals, usually dedicated to the patron saint of each village. Then, there are processions to the music of the Philharmonic Band and fireworks that light up the sky; bulls are set free through the streets of the villages; and there is folklore. These are festive days, with something for all tastes. There is also bullfighting, for fans of the festa brava, during the traditional festivals of Amieira.

A very special ritual, and one which is deeply engrained in the hearts of the people, is the devotion to the Santo Lenho (Holy Cross), which takes place in the ancient church of Vera Cruz for the duration of the festivities there.

FEIRA DO MONTADO THE OAK FAIR

The mountains of Portel contain some of the most interesting oak groves in the region, occupying more than half of the county's woodlands.

The great range of resources offered by the oak groves is reflected in the variety of products produced. Some, such as cork, are very valuable; but there is also timber, firewood and coal, and food products like honey and mushrooms. There are also many activities associated with this environment, such as animal rearing, hunting and nature tourism.

Given the potential that the oak grove represents for the development of the region, the year 2000 saw the start of the Feira do Montado (Oak Fair), an event which has become an important way of valuing these resources, economically, environmentally, culturally and scientifically.

It includes a display of local handicrafts and regional products; there are stands devoted to animal rearing activities and the chance to sample local cuisine. Cork, of course, occupies the position of honor.

There are also colloquies, lectures, and presentations of projects on the subject, all of which contribute to the growing internationalization of the event.

Alongside these initiatives, there are various forms of entertainment, such as theatre, activities for children, folk music, traditional Alentejo folk music, and concerts by important names from the national music scene. These activities fill the days and the evenings of the Feira do Montado (Oak Fair), attracting a wide variety of people.

At the end of November, all roads lead to Portel, the "Capital of the Oak Groves".



CONGRESSO DAS AÇORDAS GASTRONOMY CONGRESS

The Gastronomy Congress - Açordas is an event that intends to call attention to one of the most emblematic and original dishes of Alentejo's gastronomy – the Açorda (a kind of bread-based stew). It is a forum, a space of sharing and debating a wide range of issues related to our gastronomic heritage.

Happening at the same time, there's a Gastronomic and Regional Products Fair, where you can taste all of the "thousand and one varieties of Açorda" that Portel has to offer.

Exhibitions, contests, fado and Alentejo's traditional folk music will fill your days and nights during the Açordas Congress, in the end of March.

Every year, this event attracts thousands of visitors.



GASTRONOMY

The range of cuisine on offer in the county of Portel is rich and varied. There are a thousand and one varieties of açorda (a kind of bread-based stew) and soup, as many as the imagination will allow - açordas and soups made with dogfish, garlic; others of purslane, tomatoes, broad beans, and still others with fried meat, depending on the season of the year. All of them of course make use of the magnificent olive oil from Portel, an essential ingredient.

In winter, pork is an important component of the migas (or bread soups), boiled stews with chickpeas or rechina (pig-blood soups). After a pig killing, pork offal prepared with blood is the compulsory dish, as are the various kinds of high-quality sausages and blood sausages. As this is a region of game, you should not miss the chance to try out the many dishes based upon venison, wild boar, rabbit, hare and partridge.

The local people also retain some traditional habits, such as, in February and March, collecting cilarcas, a variety of mushroom that is a compulsory ingredient in the calducho (kind of migas with cod and pennyroyal), and in the lamb stews. Herbs like pennyroyal or river mint are precious condiments for dishes prepared with river fish.

Cheeses made of goats' and sheep's milk, and honey, are other specialities of the county. There are also regional sweets, such as the famous puff pastry cakes filled with chila (a kind of gourd); the bolo podre (literally 'rotten cake') of Portel, honey cake, pupias (cakes made of flour, eggs and lard) and biscuits. There are also fried sweets, like filhoses, pastéis de grão (corn pastries), borrachos or bêbados – prepared for Christmas and at Carnival, alongside sweet rice, which completes a vast range of irresistible specialities.

OLIVE OIL

Olive oil is an essential ingredient in Alentejo cuisine and has been present in the habits and customs of the south since time immemorial. The production of this "sacred oil" is therefore very important for the local economy of Portel county.

Portel olive oil is of unrivalled quality. It is made from the Galician variety of olive, which predominates in the olive groves around the Portel Mountains, and which give it its special taste and aroma.

The oil is extracted by the Portel Agricultural Cooperative. The modern system of extraction, with careful control of temperature and hygiene, not to mention the high quality of the olives, ensure that the final product is of excellent quality and extremely pure, with a low acidity level.

S. Pedro olive oil is a certified product, which has been distinguished at a number of competitions, both in Portugal and abroad. It was awarded 1st and 2nd Prize at the National Virgin Olive Oil Fair (Olivomoura) in 1999; the Certificate of Quality at the International Medal for Quality (Swiss Gold Medal for Quality) in 1987, and 1st Prize at the 1st Fair of Agricultural Municipalities in 2001. S. Pedro olive oil is marketed as Denomination of Origin, Extra Virgin 0.5° and Extra Virgin 0.7°.

HANDICRAFT

Handicrafts are the testimony to the habits and customs of a people, as seen in the preparation of objects for daily life. Cork utensils, such as the cochos for drinking fresh water from the drinking fountains and tarros, for carrying food to work; wooden spoons and forks, hand-carved by shepherds with a pocket knife - these are just some examples of the handicrafts that are still produced in the municipality, namely in the parish of Santana. Wrought iron is produced in Portel. In the village of Alqueva, which has given its name to the great dam, we can also find boots (botas caneleiras) in goatskin or cowhide, made in the traditional fashion.

Cork is of course the prize material, used in a great majority of the objects produced in the county - scarcely surprising, since this is a region of oak groves, where the cork oak predominates.

Other crafts on offer in the county include hand painted tiles; pewter work, painting on pottery and glass, and lacework.
